PURPOSE: The Hawkins Family Organization began in 1985. It is conducted by mail and has no scheduled meetings. We want to promote genealogical research on Hawkins families and related lines; to promote and share family history; and to strengthen extended family ties.

QUERIES: Members are also encouraged to send queries to the editor. Send enough to cover your questions. Please include siblings whenever possible.

MEMBERS AND SUBSCRIPTIONS: We began *HAWKINS HERITAGE* with the hope of identifying the parents of James and Margaret ? Hawkins, b. c1765 and 1768, probably in Virginia. Taxation records show that they lived in Stafford CO Virginia from 1793 until 1825, when they migrated to Clark CO Kentucky. One son, John R., married into the Hawkins/Bourne line, which may be a connecting branch of the above James. Because of an apparent need for group research, our publication is now open to descendants of all Hawkins lines.

Individual membership and subscription is \$12 per year. Contributing Membership and subscription is \$20 per year (may vote.)

Subscriptions begin with the April issue. Subscribers during the membership year may receive back issues of the current year or begin with the next year and pay for and single back issues, which are \$4 each. The 1st issue: December 1986; 2nd, April 1987; then three issues per year beginning April 1988 to current.

PEDIGREE SERVICE: You are welcome to send your Hawkins pedigree chart to be checked with our collection. You will be given any additional information which we might have on file, that would match up with your own. Your chart will be filed for possible future contact. QUERY

I am seeking help from anyone who has information and verification regarding the following person.

Coleman (or John Coleman) Hawkins

My family bible has a listing of Coleman Hawkins, married to Sarah Bond. His birth is listed as 25 Jun 1786, in Halifax, Co., Va., died 11 Oct 1863 in Hart Co., Ky, and was married on 25 Mar 1808 to the above Bond. He had 11 children, one of which was Eppy Ditus Hawkins, born 10 Mar 1822 in Va., and married Emily Bond in 1846. His death is listed as Wheatland, Mo., 16 Jan 1876.

The problem is as follows,

I have information regarding a John Coleman, or Coleman, who married Nancy Bond on 21 Sept 1813.

The information regarding the Coleman I wish is he traveled to Miller Co., Mo., c: 1840, and returned to Ky., where he died and was buried. His connection to Eppy Ditus Hawkins is my problem.

Does anyone have any information as to his father, mother, etc?

I also have a copy of Wilson's History of Hickory County (Mo.) dated 1906 in my possession. I will gladly exchange information from this book. It lists the history of all towns etc. in Hickory County, along with many of the prominent persons of that time (1906). I also have a copy of the History of Weaubleau, Mo., entered in the INDEX, a paper from Hermitage, Mo., dated 22 Apr 1998, and carries the byline of "History Feature: Weaubleau had County's only College, Railroad". It has an error or two that I know of personally, but is informative.

I have had little help from the Miller County people I have contacted.

NOT THE SAME AS BASEBALL CARDS

Friendship cards

"I'll be forever thine,
if thou wilt let me.
While the bright sun doth shine,
I'll ne'er forget thee."

Yesterday, colorful friendship cards were not just for girls--boys used them too, although they were not as ornate. Out of the special mementoes saved by my great-grandmother Permella Nickell Hawkins of George's Creek, Texas, her many cards are among my favorites.

The dictionary defines a "friend" as a person whom one knows, trusts, and likes. A friend is someone you can talk to because you know your words will be heard. In the 1800s, both adults and young people used their lovely friendship cards when calling upon someone, or they simply traded them. This was done in much the same way as baseball cards are traded today, except the value was friendship.

The bottom layer of the card was white with scalloped or intricately carved borders. Some even had a delicate feathery trim. The most popular design was a hand holding a nosegay or bouquet. Another favorite was an embossed dove or bluebird.

Lifting the lavish top portion of the card displayed the name of the person who presented it. The name was usually written with a flourish of the pen.

Some of the cards were imprinted with verses, much like those found in old-time autograph albums. A young lady

might have chosen a card with the following verse for a youth about whom she was starry-eyed.

"Could'st thou be true to me
In joy or in sorrow,
Dearest, thy bride I'd be,
Wed thee tomorrow!"

Great-Grandmother saved her friendship cards as if she knew descendants would love them. She was right. Such pleasure they give. Another verse of an 1891 card is:

"May you always have what you desire,
And find the one you most admire."

With the passage of time, the community of George's Creek disappeared, but not the memories. In the area cemetery, I recognized names on gravestones of friends who presented my great-grandmother with her lovely friendship cards.

If you are fortunate to have one, two, or even a collection, and want to display them, there is a correct way to do so. Consider having color photocopies made for framing. Then keep the original another hundred years in acid-free sleeves in your scrapbook. But if you really want to frame the original, choose an acid-free mat and a metal frame. Wooden frames can eventually cause damage.

Perhaps you will run across one of these beautiful cards one day--with the nineteenth-century signature of someone's friend.

Please follow these guidelines for your submission.

1. Use standard 8 1/2 inch paper.
2. Try to leave a one inch margin on the top and sides and 1 1/2 inches on the bottom.
3. Type, print, or write legibly. Dark black ink copies the best.
4. If an item is larger than 8 1/2 x 11, and you are unable to reduce it, then send it as is to the editor to reduce.
5. Your submission may be written as a letter to the members, the editor, an article with title and author, a question or an answer to the members, or copies of documents, maps, etc.
6. If you are sending copyrighted material, please give the title, author, publisher, copyright date, and page. If it is not copyrighted, please cite the source so that credit may still be given.
7. If you want your submissions returned, please provide return postage.
8. If you send family group sheets, number each sheet in the order that it is to be interpreted. This is extremely important especially if it is used in our publication, but also for my indexed files.
9. Put your name on *every* page you send.
10. Please put the **date** on your letters as well as on the material you submit. It is helpful if you use an **inside address** on your letters. I file your letters but not the envelopes in my notebooks.
11. If you are a new member, we hope you will send a family group sheet or pedigree chart.
12. We urge our members to take advantage of submitting queries. You may do this once a year, and they can be in "standard" form or in letter form. Since we have new members all the time, your query will still be new to them.
13. Suggestions welcomed.

Dates of submission: The following dates are approximate. Sometimes I receive too much for the next issue, and at other times, I might need a little more.

By March 15 for the April issue

By July 10 for the August issue.

By November 1 for the December issue.
