- <u>PURPOSE</u>: The Hawkins Family Organization began in 1985. It is conducted by mail and has no scheduled meetings. We want to promote genealogical research on Hawkins families and related lines; to promote and share family history; and to strengthen extended family ties.

- <u>OUERIES</u>: Members are also encouraged to send queries to the editor. Send enough to cover your questions. Please include siblings whenever possible.
- MEMBERS AND SUBSCRIPTIONS: We began HAWKINS HERITAGE with the hope of identifying the parents of James and Margaret? Hawkins, b. c1765 and 1768, probably in Virginia. Taxation records show that they lived in Stafford CO Virginia from 1793 until 1825, when they migrated to Clark CO Kentucky. One son, John R., married into the Hawkins/Bourne line, which may be a connecting branch of the above James. Because of an apparent need for group research, our publication is now open to descendants of all Hawkins lines.

Individual membership and subscription is \$12 per year. Contributing Membership and subscription is \$20 per year (may vote.)

Subscriptions begin with the April issue. Subscribers during the membership year may receive back issues of the current year or begin with the next year and pay for and single back issues, which are \$4 each. The 1st issue: December 1986; 2nd, April 1987; then three issues per year beginning April 1988 to current.

PEDIGREE SERVICE: You are welcome to send your Hawkins pedigree chart to be checked with our collection. You will be given any additional information which we might have on file, that would match up with your own. Your chart will be filed for possible future contact. 



!Age 72 at death; age 15 at the close of the Revolutionary War in 1783. !Jameson, according to the testimony of his grandaughter, Sallie Hawkins Long, was of "fair" education for the times and had a reputation for unusual intelligence. He was also an ordained preacher in the Baptist Church and a farmer. They lived for a while in Boone Co.,KY, then moved to Indianapolis. !There seems to be a mix-up with the spouses and marriage dates, etc. Since I am uncertain if this Sarah Ann Smith belongs with this Jameson Hawkins, I am leaving the marriage here for the present even though there are conflicts. (13 Jan 1997).

Combs

(From Gone With the Windmills)

Diamonds, pearls, aigrettes--these adorned the hair of wealthy women. By the end of the eighteenth-century, the use of hair-ornamentation, although not so elaborate, became popular among the middle-class.

The aigrette was a "spray" ornament resembling a plume of the white bird. It was also designed as a brooch to be used interchangeably in the hair, with diamonds the chief stones. An important feature of the design was a butterfly or bird set on a thin wire so it would move with a turn of the head.

Women who were not so prosperous could afford ornaments of pinchbeck, a zinc and copper alloy which does not tarnish. Less expensive gemstones or stones of paste were also used. Thus appeared some of the first costume jewelry. For informal occasions the decorative combs evolved into simpler designs, often curved to fit the head.

A comb's function was to remove tangles, then hold the hair in an attractive fashion. Chances are the first combs were small sticks serving to separate the hair. Somewhere along the way, someone decided on a better idea. Combs were soon made of horn. The horn was boiled in order to soften it, then rolled out like dough before being carved into the general shape of a comb.

When in their twenties, my grandmother Anna Hawkins and her three sisters wore their hair in chignons or buns, using long hairpins to keep it in place. In the early 1900s, Anna's sister, Elizabeth Frances, chose never to cut her hair, letting it grow to the floor. The weight gave her such a headache she cut the hair around her crown, then coiled the rest of her hair around it. She wore two curved combs rimmed with garnets to hold the bun in place.

Great-Uncle Thomas Clark Page returned from the Spanish-American War, bringing home a small mahogany chest filled with handmade Philippine items. The chest contained carved wooden-soled sandals, lace handkerchiefs, and wooden combs in various sizes. Carved in fine mahogany, the combs were shaped in a half-circle, with slender tines. (Clark also brought back his rifle cartridges, buttons from his uniform, his helmet's 6th Cavalry brass identification and his discharge papers. He was born in Northeastern Kentucky, and came to Texas after the war to marry his cousin, Louisa Ellen Hawkins.)

Pierced ivory combs also became popular. Spanish-style back-combs of tortoiseshell stood high behind a lady's chignon. In Mexico's tourist shops, combs are

made of bone, which is ground, then reconstituted to a product resembling plastic. Animals, flowers, and religious designs are carved into the top rim.

Today, sterling, plastic, rattail-style, and metal-tipped combs for lifting the hair, are all on the market. Collecting old combs and hair ornaments is a popular hobby. The most elaborate and valuable ones of centuries ago are now in museums or in private collections.

I'm not sure when a woman's hair was first referred to as her crowning glory. Perhaps it began with one of O'Henry's poignant stories about the young woman who sold her hair to buy her husband a watch fob, only to find he had sold his watch to buy a comb for her hair.

I recently received a letter from Ken Barron, who is searching for information concerning Malinda B. Hawkins, who married Daniel Sartor in 1825. He states that various records show Daniel Sartor (b. 2/11/1789 SC; d. 6/13/1873 AL) was the son of William and Rebecca (Hughes) Sartor of Union County, South Carolina. (Daniel Sartor is named as a son in the 1829 will of William Sartor, and he is also referenced in the 1855 will of Rebecca Sartor as "Daniel Sartor, resident of Alabama.")

"The only reference, that I have found thus far, to Daniel Sartor's wife comes in a pension claim (for service during the War of 1812) filed by Daniel Sartor June 6, 1871, in Crenshaw County, Alabama, in which he said he married Malinda B. Hawkins in 1825.

"It is not known where Daniel Sartor was living in 1825, he may have been living in Alabama, possibly Pike County. There are federal land patent letters showing that Daniel Sartor purchased land in Pike County, in August 1832. Evidently Daniel spent the rest of his life in Pike County (and that part of Pike County that later became the Crenshaw County, Alabama.) He is shown in the 1859, 2860 and 1870 censuses."

Please follow these guidelines for your submission.

- 1. Use standard 8 1/2 inch paper.
- 2. Try to leave a one inch margin on the top and sides and 1 1/2 inches on the bottom.
- 3. Type, print, or write legibly. Dark black ink copies the best.
- 4. If an item is larger than 8 1/2 x 11, and you are unable to reduce it, then send it as is to the editor to reduce.
- 5. Your submission may be written as a letter to the members, the editor, an article with title and author, a question or an answer to the members, or copies of documents, maps, etc.
- 6. If you are sending copyrighted material, please give the title, author, publisher, copyright date, and page. If it is not copyrighted, please cite the source so that credit may still be given.
- 7. If you want your submissions returned, please provide return postage.
- 8. If you send family group sheets, <u>number</u> each sheet in the order that it is to be interpreted. This is extremely important especially if it is used in our publication, but also for my indexed files.
- 9. Put your name on every page you send.
- 10. Please put the date on your letters as well as on the material you submit. It is helpful if you use an inside address on your letters. I file your letters but not the envelopes in my notebooks.
- 11. If you are a new member, we hope you will send a family group sheet or pedigree chart.
- 12. We urge our members to take advantage of submitting queries. You may do this once a year, and they can be in "standard" form or in letter form. Since we have new members all the time, your query will still be new to them.
- 13. Suggestions welcomed.
