<u>PURPOSE</u>: The Hawkins Family Organization began in 1985. It is conducted by mail and has no scheduled meetings. We want to promote genealogical research on Hawkins families and related lines; to promote and share family history; and to strengthen extended family ties.

NEWSLETTERS: HAWKINS HERITAGE is published three times a year in April, August, and December. We encourage members to contribute material to the editor. It is preferable if you type your material, but if not covenient, please share it anyway. Write your name or initials on each page.

QUERIES: Members are also encouraged to send queries to the editor. Send enough to cover your questions. Please include siblings whenever possible.

MEMBERS AND SUBSCRIPTIONS: We began HAWKINS HERITAGE with the hope of identifying the parents of James and Margaret? Hawkins, b. c1765 and 1768, probably in Virginia. Taxation records show that they lived in Stafford CO Virginia from 1793 until 1825, when they migrated to Clark CO Kentucky. One son, John R., married into the Hawkins/Bourne line, which may be a connecting branch of the above James. Because of an apparent need for group research, our publication is now open to descendants of all Hawkins lines.

Individual membership and subscription is \$12 per year. Contributing Membership and subscription is \$20 per year (may vote.)

Subscriptions begin with the <u>April</u> issue. Subscribers during the membership year may receive back issues of the <u>current</u> year or begin with the next year and pay for and single back issues, which are \$4 each. The 1st issue: December 1986; 2nd, April 1987; then three issues per year beginning April 1988 to current.

PEDIGREE SERVICE: You are welcome to send your Hawkins pedigree chart to be checked with our collection. You will be given any additional information which we might have on file, that would match up with your own. Your chart will be filed for possible future contact. Our ancestor files deal mostly with Hawkins of the south and southwest, but we do have some other areas. Cost of this service is \$1 to cover search and photocopies, plus SASE.

#### Malinda B. Hawkins - Daniel Sartor

Various records show that Daniel Sartor (b. 2/11/1789 SC; d. 6/13/1873 AL) was the son of William and Rebecca (Hughes) Sartor of Union County, South Carolina. (Daniel Sartor is named as a son in the 1829 will of William Sartor, and he is also referenced in the 1855 will of Rebecca Sartor as "Daniel Sartor, resident of Alabama".) Malinda B. Hawkins married Daniel Sartor in 1825.

The only reference, that I have found thus far, to Daniel Sartor's wife comes in a pension claim (for service during the War of 1812) filed by Daniel Sartor June 6, 1871, in Crenshaw County, Alabama, in which he said he married Malinda B. Hawkins in 1825.

It is not known where Daniel Sartor was living in 1825, he may have been living in Alabama, possibly Pike County. There are federal land patent letters showing that Daniel Sartor purchased land in Pike County, Alabama, in August 1832. Evidently Daniel Sartor spent the rest of his life in Pike County (and that part of Pike County that later became Crenshaw County, Alabama). He is shown in the 1850, 1860 and 1870 censuses.

Any information you might be able to provide concerning the Malinda B. Hawkins who married Daniel Sartor in 1825 would be greatly appreciated. My mother was a Willis and my grandmother was Mattie Tilden Hawkins Willis (Married to Hiram Willis.) Her father was Simon Peter Hawkins, who settled at Burkburnett some time around 1880. If anyone has further information on Simon Peter Hawkins, please write to Jon H. Bear, 1000 Petroleum Building, P.O. Box BRC, Wichita Falls, TX 76307-7507. Note: Mr. Bear didn't give additional dates or places, although Mattie Hawkins' father-in-law (Andrew Jackson Willis) was apparently born in 1830 in Mecklenburg CO VA and died in Wichita CO TX in 1907. #### Notes on William Hawkins:

William was born in Virginia, traveled to Miller Co., Mo. in 1842, traveled back to Tennessee, returning to Miller Co. in 1850.

William was a 3<sup>rd</sup> Lt. in the 6<sup>th</sup> Missouri Volunteer Cavalry, which was organized by Col. Clark Wright at Rolla, Mo. on 14 Feb 1862. This also lists Maj. H. P. Hawkins. The unit served in southwest Missouri, Arkansas, Mississippi, and Louisiana. The unit was mustered out 12 Sep 1865 by Gen. McClernand.

William was killed in action at Helena, Ark., the date is uncertain. William is listed in the "History of Miller Co., Mo." by Jenkins, and also the "History of Miller Co. Mo.", by Shultz.

He was quoted as an "agitator" for states rights in Miller Co. for civil war (Union) in March 1861.

The Hawkins and Robinson women made the first flag of the 6<sup>th</sup> Cav. unit from dresses they had.

William and his wife were members of the Union Baptist Church which was founded in 1855, by William C. McCubbin, pastor. This church was in the Little Richwoods community. Members included William McCubbin pastor, George and Francis Payne, William-Catherine-Presley-Sarepta-and Mary F. Hawkins, Jacob and Mary McComb, Alfred and Elizabeth Devore.

## WILL OF WILLIAM HAWKINS OF FREDERICK CO. VA.

Dated 2/25/1782 Frederick Co. Virginia

"Sick and weak, but sound in mind and memory I give wife, Jane (Sharp) Hawkins 2 cows and her third of all movable estate for her lifetime. My land I give to my 3 youngest sons, each to have one third share. Abel-Asa-Moses- when they come of age. Land to be sold and equally divided-if one should choose to keep all the land, he is to pay the others. To my son John Hawkins, 1 horse or Mair, 2 yearling calves, 1 ewe 1 lamb. To son Richard Hawkins, 1 horse or Mair (mare) 2 yearling calves, 1 ewe, 1 lamb. To son Abel Hawkins, 1 ewe, 1 lamb, and one third of the land. To son Asa Hawkins, 1 ewe, 1 lamb and one third of the land. To son Moses Hawkins 1 ewe, 1 lamb and his share of the land. To my eldest son William Hawkins 1 give 1 shilling in Sterling. I appoint my friends Peter Catlett and John Shurman Woodcock to be my executors". (2/25/1782)

Wit: John Mead-Abraham Cleavenger-John Thorp

Court dated 6 Jun 1782- Executors would not serve. At a court in Frederick Co. Va. 4 Jun 1782. Will was exhibited and proved by the above named executors and on the motion of Jane Hawkins, the widow, the will was to stand and be recorded, and she was appointed Exetrix, as the original executors resigned.

## WILL OF THOMAS SHARP

Will dated 1/13/1762-proved April Court in 1762

"I Thomas Sharp, Sr.-County of Frederick, Colony of Va. Weak in body but perfect in mind and memory After all just debts are paid, furneal expenses fully paid. My stated: Land and stock and household goodsto go to wife Elizabeth Sharp during her life; except 50 acres of land touching Churchman's lines and down the Hollow to Robert Hains' lines to go to son, Thomas Sharp. The balance of the land, after wife Elizabeth Sharp dies to go to the sons of my son Thomas Sharp-Thomas Sharp, Jr., John Sharp, William Sharp. If any of my grandsons die without issue, the land to revert to a living brother with issue. Daus. Rebecca Churchman, Elizabeth Nathan, Sarah Lane (or Love), Ann Haines, Jane Hawkins, Mary Remay, Mary Frazier- They to have in 6 months after my decease, I shilling in sterling-each. To my daughter Esther (or Easter) Sharp, she to have 20 shillings of current money, 6 months after my decease. To Mary Churchman, dau of Edward Churchman, 20 shillings of current money to be paid when she comes of age". Sole executor, my wife Elizabeth Sharp.

# THIS OL' BARN Or any ol' barn

Which came first, the house or the barn? The latter was an absolute necessity in cold climates. As farmers obtained oxen for their farms, they also needed barns for their oxen. The structure was often built first for the animals' protection, and the family endured living in a dugout until they could build their house.

Barns provided space for livestock and stalls for horses. Hay was stacked on a loft and could be pitched to the floor below. At the end of the second level, an opening allowed the hay to be hurled down to a waiting wagon. Some barns were built into the side of a hill so both floors were accessible from ground level.

Early settlers stored grain in thatched-roof barns, but they needed frequent replacement. Rough bark shingles, just as they were stripped from the trees, replaced the thatched roof. Later, logs were split, providing a more serviceable roof.

Before "real" paint was used, linseed oil provided a durable penetration. Red iron oxide gave the color associated with red barns. The color became acceptable all over the country. Directions such as "Turn left at the blue barn" just didn't sound right.

As people took more pride in their barns, they added fancy cupolas or personal distinctive touches. Crossboard trims were painted white. They were built structurally stronger and became elaborate with a hand-carved whirligig or weather-vane on top.

Progressing to modern times, some people were enamored with the beauty of large barns, and converted many into houses, or purchased the weathered wood for use in their dens. The structures were carefully dismantled to salvage as much material as possible.

Many barns are restored because of their historical quality, whether or not they are really used for anything more practical than storage. Barns all over the country stand fine and proud, but some resemble a swayback horse. Others have shed their color, begging for a coat of paint.

Today when you see a dilapidated barn looming over the hillside, look again. Was it built by newlyweds for grain, cattle, or a new tractor? . . . the tractor now sitting by the broken gate, rusted with no seat, no tires. The windows in the old farm house are shattered and the roof has fallen over the porch. Both may surrender with the next wind.

Until then, the barn won't give up, and likely will never tell its story.
