Main census table with columns: Name, Sex, Age, Marital Status, Occupation, Health, Education, Nativity. Includes entries for Marshall Joseph W., Harrison John, and others.

Note D.—In making entries in columns 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, an affirmative mark only will be used—thus A, except in the case of divorced persons, column 11, when the letter "D" is to be used.
Note E.—Question No. 12 will be asked in all cases where an affirmative answer has been given either to question 10 or to question 11.
Note F.—Question No. 14 will be asked in all cases where a marital description has been reported in column 10.
Note G.—In column 7 an affirmative mark only will be used, as Jan., Apr., Dec.
