## NOTES ON PICKETT/MACKAY CHARTS

by W. D. Coleman March 19, 1989

### MacKays:

The MacKay chart is all I currently have on the lineage of my grandmother, Mildred MacKay. I have heard there may be a book on the MacKays, but I have not searched it out yet. The chart remains unnumbered until I have a chance to put together a booklet on the ancestors and descendants of Caryl Voight and Mildred (MacKay) Pickett.

New Information: The chart was retyped from the chart in the booklet, The Pickett Genealogy, ca. Spring 1983 by Laris Pickett. To that chart has been added (1) the parents of Sarah Ann Deems Isehart found in the 1850 Census of Cumberland, Maryland when she was 7 years old, and (2) The year of death for Sarah Ellen Nellie Shaffer as found on her gravestone in Union Cemetery, S.E. of Rose Hill, KS.

### Picketts:

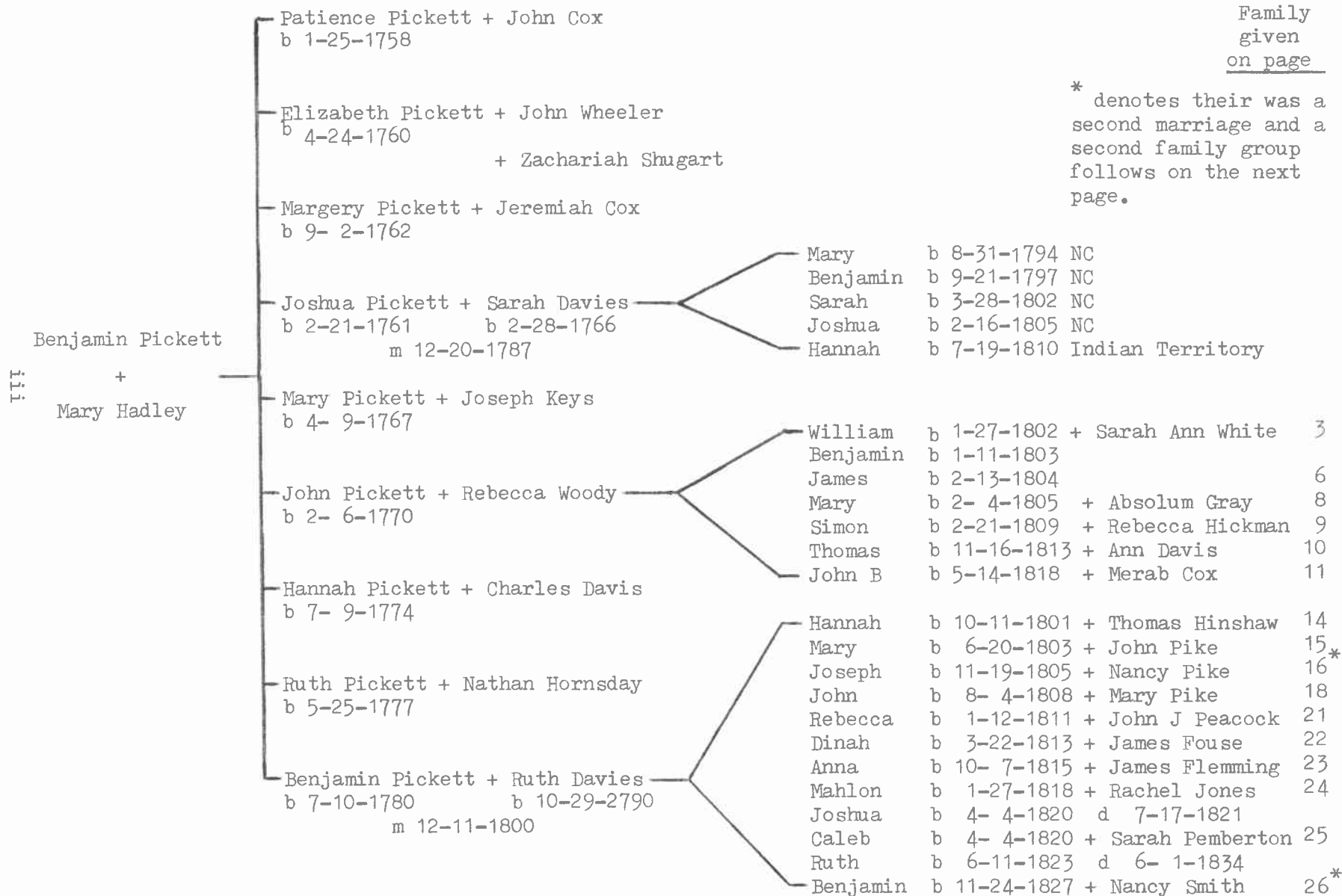
I had a wealth of information handed to me in two places. First, the booklet mentioned above is a good starting point, though no pedigree chart is included, and was one of two things which got me interested in studying my family tree. Second, the Mid America Yearly Meeting of Friends maintains archives at the Edmund Stanley Library on the Friends University campus. The archivist, Elaine MacEK, had made pedigree charts for the Picketts and Hinshaws from the materials available to her which include church records from Rose Hill Monthly Meeting and a manuscript by Willard Heiss, of Indianapolis, Indiana entitled Some Descendants of Benjamin<sup>Pickett</sup> and his wife, Mary [Hadley] Pickett. Pickett Chart 1 starting with Caryl Voight Pickett is complete back four prior generations and is continued on Pickett Charts 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6. Family group charts for Caryl's fathers are found in the booklet, The Pickett Genealogy, through Benjamin and Ruth Pickett. Prior to this Benjamin and Mary Hadleys family is found in the Heiss manuscript. Benjamin and Mary [Hadley] Pickett appear three times, see charts 2, 3, & 4.

The Heiss typescript had no table of contents or index  
I added a typed table of contents as pages i and ii  
and then created a tree for 3 generations as page iii.  
This set of three pages summarizes the 58 pages of  
information which is not economical to reproduce without reformatting  
it onto ~~or~~ less pages.

The repetition of family ~~name~~ names just 4 generations prior  
to Caryl Voight Pickett (Chart 1) is interesting: Piggott (or Pickett) (2)  
Hinsbaw (2), Cox (3), & Davis (3).

Tucker'S History of Randolph Co., Ind p. 433: "In 1818, he (William Pickett) went to Chatham Co., N C (on the Haw River), to care for his grandfather. He died in 1821, and W P after staying until the fall of 1822, emigrated to Richmond, Ind. He was married in 1826, and moved to Randolph County, five miles east of Winchester, in 1828. He bought eighty acres of Benjamin Cox. Benjamin Cox was a Quaker minister and cousin to W P, since (Benjamin Coxes mother, Patience, was a sister to W P's grandfather, Benjamin Pickett).

Mr. Pickett married (1875) for his second wife, Mary (Hiatt) Coats. Mr. Pickett has always been a member of the Society of Friends."

James Pickett's wife, Priscilla (Pike?), died when William was 3 weeks old. When William was 2 years old the family came to Indiana in 1826 from Orange County, No. Carolina. They settled in Randolph Co., and in 1831 moved to Spiceland in Henry County.

Some several years later (probably when the children were grown) James moved to Kansas and died there.

William and Lydia belonged to West Grove Meeting of Friends, but because they lived an extreme distance from a meetinghouse, all of the children joined the Wesleyan Methodists in Bakers Corner, near 1870. That is, all, except William O.

Dear Harvey,

After leaving you dear friends, on 4th day P. M. we drove to Barnesville Ohio, reaching there at 12 midnight. Attended Ridge Meeting on 5th day. I helped my son-in-law do some concrete work on 6th and 7th days. And attended meeting again at Ridge on 1st day, and at 3 P. M. Anna Edgerton and Mattie Sanders and I left for Salem, Ohio where we visited Anna's son Vergil. Left there on 2nd day A. M. at 6 and I got to my home at 3 the next morning. Having drove 544 miles. We stopped near Roanoke, Va. for a while to see Anna's Aunt, and cousin; also her sister Mabel. And as Mattie had been car sick a good part of the way, we found a room at a hotel in Roanoke for her. And she went on home from there on third day.

I found all well at home for which I trust I am sufficiently thankful, and grateful for the privilege of attending your Yearly Meeting.

I hope that the favored seasons may be a lasting inspiration to me, for I felt so poor and weak before leaving my home to go to Indiana.

We have had lots of rain since I came home the storms reached here last P. M. and such a downpour of rain I never have seen, and today the streams are the highest in the known history.

Well Harvey, I have been looking into my records for information on thy family. And have found some data that I think will be of interest to thee. At least it is to me, for we are related, on the Hadley side. And I find that Benjamin 'Piggott' son of John and Margaret (in another place her name was spelled 'Marger'). Benjamin was born in Sycil County, Maryland 9-29-1732 and died at Cane Creek, (which is about 10 miles from our home).

Mary, his wife, was the daughter of Joshua and Patience Hadley. She was born in New Castle County, Pa. (sic) 1-30-1739 and died 10-31-1810.
