- GREEN, THOMAS, CONT., Matthews, Elizabeth, b. Rhode Island. SERVICE: Thomas Green enlisted in the Rhode Island regiment as an orderly, and was on Gen. Nathaniel Green's staff-Gcn. Green being his first cousin. Thomas Green made trips thru the British lines without detection 84 times. He served continuously until the end of the war, and was made Judge advocate and Land Commissioner of the territory of Indiana located at Brookville, Indiana. He was drowned while rescuing a surveter out of a stream called Driftwood, in what is now Bartholomew Co., Ind.
