## Donald Taylor

Donald William Taylor, 43, of 1812 Summer St., Grinnell, died Tuesday, July 12, at Coralville.

The death was ruled a suicide.

Graveside services were conducted Saturday at Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Rev. Raymond C. Lott, pastor of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, officiating.

The son of William and Ruth Paulson Taylor, he was born June 14, 1946, at Montezuma. He received his education at Brooklyn. Mr. Taylor

served as a medical specialist with the U.S. Army for two years.

Following his discharge, he worked at the Donaldson Co. in Grinnell, then worked with various trucking firms in Iowa and Wisconsin. He was employed by the Barr-Nunn Trucking Co. of Granger at the time of his death.

Surviving are his parents; two sisters, Jean Massengale of Moberly, Mo., and Joyce Taylor of Altoona; and one brother, Kenneth of Des Moines.
