Now know ye, that there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Daniel H. Watts* the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Daniel H. Watts* and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I, *Benjamin Harrison*, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
