He was buried in Rabun Creek Baptist Church, Hickory Tavern, Laurens South Carolina. At least one member of the Bolt family is buried in the same cemetery. He was married to Ann KELLET in 1764. **Ann KELLET** was born about 1742 in Laurens County, South Carolina. John Joseph ABERCROMBIE and Ann KELLET had the following children:

3. **James ABERCROMBIE Sr.** was born about 1765. He died about 1825. From Tom Hartman: 3 Jul 1817 - H. Montgomery writes of whites in Cherokee territory (old Forsyth Co. boundaries): "on or near Chestatee and at and above the Shallowford, James Abercrombie, Sr., James Abercrombie, Jr." 24 Jul 1817 - he writes, "moved or are moving, James Abercrombie, Sr." James appears in Jackson County records in 1801 when he purchased a pair of "sissors" from the estate of Joseph Neal.

From Kelvin R. Moore:

James, Sr. - Enumerated in 1790 census Laurens County, SC, sold property in 1798, then enumerated in Jackson County, GA in 1805. Capt. of militia district in Hall County, GA in 1820. Wife Ann or Mary Ann and eight children (named).

He was married to Mary Ann BECK in 1784 in Laurens, South Carolina. **Mary Ann BECK** was born about 1765. Her name is also given as Williams and Avery, but Tom Hartman says there is an oral tradtiion for the name Beck which the others lack.

Kelvin Moore gives her name as Williams, but notes there is no documentation for the name and that "It is now being reported as 'Beck.'".

She may have been a Cherokee. Her son Young David had a son, John Green Abercrombie who had a son Young David Abercrombie who was supposedly one-fourth Cherokee. Mrs. William Earp, granddaughter of Young William, wrote in 1983: "Young William was supposed to have been 1/4 Cherokee Indian. He was dark and was called 'Cherokee Bill'. He did not file for an Indian Roll Number, his father or brother did. Young William's grandfather [sic] was supposed to have married a full-blooded Cherokee lady by the name of Beck" (The Descendants of James Abercrombie, 1765-1825, compiled by Karen L. Robert) The same oral tradition comes through other descendants of Young David Abercrombie and is quoted in this book. It would have been Young William's great grandmother, though. Also, their daughter Elizabeth died in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory. James ABERCROMBIE Sr. and Mary Ann BECK had the following children:

10. **Christiana ABERCROMBIE** was born in 1785 in Laurens, South Carolina. On July 19, 1817, James sold half of his land in the Cherokee Nation East, in Jackson County, to his son-in-law Alexander Crawford. Kelvin Moore speculates this was land set aside for the Indians and James had to vacate it. This suggests Crawford was a Cherokee.

She was married to Alexander CRAWFORD on 24 Sep 1807 in Jackson County, Georgia.

- 11. **James ABERCROMBIE** was born about 1786. He died about 1840. Six children. He was married to Mary HAMILTON about 1822 in Hall County, Georgia. James ABERCROMBIE and Mary HAMILTON had the following children:

James (Jacob) PECK (son of Adam PECK and Eliza GALE (GAYLE)) was born about 1830 in Tennessee. He died on 31 Dec 1863 in Atlanta, Georgia. Paulette Ownby's research shows this to be Jacob Peck. His brother James having moved west and died in Oklahoma. A Jacob G. Peck appears in the 1860 census in Lumpkin County.

He enlisted in the Confederate army about October 4, 1863 (Company H, 66th Georgia Regiment). He was at Lookout Mountain, Tennessee and died of pneumonia in Atlanta.. Jane ABERCROMBIE and James (Jacob) PECK had the following children:

- 21. **John Hamilton, Jr. ABERCROMBIE** was born on 22 Dec 1822 in Lumpkin County, Georgia. He died on 30 Sep 1864 in Hall County, Georgia. Died of yellow fever in General Hospital #9. He was a private in the 9th Georgia Infantry, Comapny B or H.

He was married to Catherine Sarah PECK (daughter of Adam PECK and Eliza GALE (GAYLE)) on 8 Oct 1846 in Lumpkin County, Georgia. **Catherine Sarah PECK** was born on 21 Jan 1824 in Jefferson County, Tennessee. She died on 25 May 1864 in Lake City, Florida. She lived in Lake City, Florida, and presumably died there, of yellow fever. Her husband also died of yellow fever later that year in an army hospital.

22. **Hannah ABERCROMBIE** was born in 1808 in Laurens Co., S.C.. She died in 1891 in Anderson Co., S.C.. She was buried in Asbury Methodist Church Cemetery. Her tombstone reads: "She believed and sleeps in Jesus". Pat Williford and others show her name as Crombie.

She was married to Asa BOLT (son of John Lewis BOLT Sr. and Nancy LINDLEY). **Asa BOLT** was born in 1803. He died in 1876 in Anderson Co., S.C.. He was buried in Asbury Methodist Church Cemetery.
