6. John<sup>2</sup> Abercrombie (James<sup>1</sup>) was born 1792 in SC, and died January 1864 in Lumpkin, GA. He married Fannie Cavender Bef. 1822 in Hall, GA, daughter of Clemeth Cavender and Rebecca Dedman.

Notes for John Abercrombie:

The 1820 federal census of Hall county enumerates three families of Abercrombies. There were two men by the name of James and one John Abercrombie. The name is often also spelled: Abercromby, Abercrumby, and Abbercrombie, but all seem to be the same family. The Abercrombies apparently came to Hall county from South Carolina by way of Jackson County, Ga.
