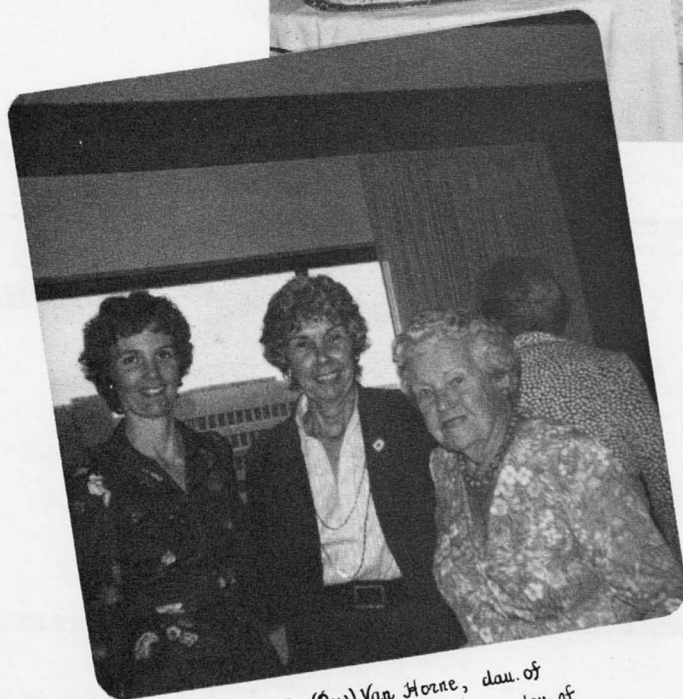

Margaret Fritschi's father, Joseph Pritchard spent over 50 years with the telegraphic company, moving to Hawaii when it was a monarchy. A new gov't was formed in 1900, as a Territory, with Prince Kuhio, a real Hawaiian, serving as a delegate to Washington for many years - but with no vote. In 1959 Hawaii became a State and three voting members now represent that State. The Fritschi's were in Honolulu when it was bombed by the Japanese on Dec 7, 1941; they did not leave the islands as so many others did. Margaret became a Gray Lady at the Tripler Army Hospital. In 1972 the Fritschi's celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary. Margaret claims (in 1980) she has lived in the same home in Honolulu for 59 years.
