Directions

1. Take Autoroute 5 north from Gatineau to the end, left onto Route 105 north, continue 3.6 km past the Wakefield roundabout, turn left onto Chemin

Maclaren, go 2.5 km and continue left onto Chemin Shouldice, go 4.5 km to the intersection in Rupert, continue straight onto Chemin Parent, go 600 m then left onto Chemin Moncrieff (there are cottage signs, including Johannsen), go 500 m (keep left at the first fork in the road), turn right at Chemin Johannsen.

2. Alternative route with less dirt road - turn left onto 366 Ouest 1.3 km after the Wakefield roundabout, go 6.4 km, turn right onto Chemin de la Beurrerie just before the left turn to Lac Phillipe, go 2.2 km, keep right on Chemin des Erables, go 3.9 km to Rupert, turn left onto Chemin Parent.)
