TRAVEL

From East:

1. Take Queensway (417) east to Moodie Drive, head south on Moodie Drive.

2. Keep right on Richmond Rd. (Hwy 59) where Richmond & Moodie Drive (Hwy 11)split. Continue on Richmond Rd. for approx. 10 km. while crossing Fallowfield Rd, and follow the river, to the lights at Eagleson Rd.

3.Continue into Richmond, passing the Richmond nursery on your left, until you come to the next stoplight, with the Arena and Bakery on your right. At the light turn left onto McBean St.

4. Head three blocks south on McBean passing through the light at the Public school. Just before the bridge turn right on Strachan St.

5. Dave and Wendy are at 108 Strachan, the last house on the left. There is an empty lot across the street from their home, please feel free to park there.

From West:

1. Take Queensway (417) west to Eagleson Rd. Head south on Eagleson, through Kanata, and continue south until you reach the lights at the Richmond nursery. Turn right into Richmond. From here the directions are the same starting at #3 above.
