

McHARGUE MILL ON LITTLE LAUREL RIVER  
LEVI JACKSON WILDERNESS STATE PARK  
LONDON, KENTUCKY

This State Park located on U. S. 25, between London and Corbin, is a historical shrine to the memory of the pioneers who were slain on October 3, 1786, by a band of Indians. This was the bloodiest Indian massacre ever to occur in Kentucky.

The 24 members of the McNitt Company are buried a short distance from the mill. In the mill yard is one of the largest collections of old millstones in the world.
