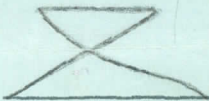

FIRST DAY

SECOND DAY

Arrive Washington, D. C. - Breakfast in the Savarin Restaurant in the Union Station. Baggage will be transferred from trainside to Trailways Bus. Before leaving Washington we will visit the U. S. CAPITOL BUILDING. Nearby we see the SUPREME COURT BUILDING and the CONGRESSIONAL LIBRARY. Group photograph with the Capitol Building in the background. Before leaving Washington for New York, we will visit the WAX MUSEUM.

Enroute to New York City, stop will be made for luncheon.

Arrive New York City - Check into hotel rooms.

7:30 P.M. Attend performance at RADIO CITY MUSIC HALL, to see a first run screen presentation and the famous ROCKETTE LINE on stage.

THIRD DAY

8:30 A.M. This morning we board our glass top sightseeing bus for a tour of LOWER MANHATTAN, seeing the LITTLE CHURCH AROUND THE CORNER, the FINANCIAL DISTRICT, stopping for a tour through CHINATOWN, visiting several curio shops and a mission. We ride along the BOWERY, the "Street of Forgotten Men" and for contrast, we see the swank BEEKMAN HILL DISTRICT. Included this morning is a visit to the OBSERVATION DECK OF THE EMPIRE STATE BUILDING, and a tour through the UNITED NATIONS BUILDING.

Return to hotel - time to secure lunch.

2:00 P.M. Transfer to Pier 83 at Hudson River and board the CIRCLE LINE YACHT for a delightful three hour sightseeing tour around Manhattan Island. The yacht is equipped with a public address system, and as you enjoy a relaxing cruise, your guide will point out the FINANCIAL DISTRICT, BATTERY PARK, the STATUE OF LIBERTY, the BROOKLYN BRIDGE, MANHATTAN BRIDGE, THE NAVY YARD (where you'll get a glimpse of our large fishing ships), the UNITED NATIONS BUILDING, and the famed homes of wealth on Sutton Place. You sail under the TRI-BORO BRIDGE, into the HARLEM RIVER, where you'll see YANKEE STADIUM, the POLO GROUNDS and then head into the Hudson River where you'll pass under the GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE, second largest span in the world. You'll then pass by many of the huge ocean liners before docking at the starting point of this interesting cruise.

FOURTH DAY

After lunch at the hotel board sightseeing bus in Washington and

1:30 P.M. drive through residential Washington, passing many EMBASSIES AND LEGATIONS. Through ROCK CREEK PARK, the site of the ZOO, and stop for a short visit at the LINCOLN MEMORIAL. Next stop is ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY. Here we see the " CHANGING OF THE GUARD " at the TOMB OF THE UNKNOWN SOLDIERS. Then to the IWO JIMA MEMORIAL and on through ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA to MOUNT VERNON, home and last resting place of George and Martha Washington.

Returning from Mount Vernon, we pass the WASHINGTON NATIONAL AIRPORT and the PENTAGON BUILDING, and also pay a short visit to the JEFFERSON MEMORIAL.

Dinner at the hotel - Evening free.

FIFTH DAY

After breakfast, board our bus for a visit to the BUREAU OF ENGRAVING AND PRINTING, WASHINGTON MONUMENT and the WHITE HOUSE.

Luncheon at the hotel and check out of rooms.

This afternoon, visit the SMITHSONIAN INSTITUTE, MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY and the ARCHIVES BUILDING.

Dinner at the hotel.
