PLQB notes on page 195 that Catherine Clapp, dau. of Joseph Clapp and Nancy Miller, was married to Levi Baldwin and settled near Hamilton, Ontario. The children of Jesse Baldwin acknowledge in several documents that their parents were Jesse Baldwin and Catherine Clapp. Regardless of whether Catherine first married Levi and later married his brother Jesse or the author of PLQB erred in naming the brother of Jesse as her husband, the known offspring of Catherine Clapp were fathered by Jesse Baldwin. There is some family tradition that Catherine was married prior to her marriage to Jesse Baldwin but there is no documentation found to that effect.

The parents of Levi and Jesse Baldwin were Jesse Baldwin and Olive Gasset of Massachusetts. After Jesse was born in 1789 the family moved to Andover, VT in time for the 1790 census. Children born to Jesse and Olive in Andover include Benjamin (6/11/1792), Silas (9/18/1794 – died before 1797), Silas (6/27/1797) and fraternal twins Lewis and Olive (6/8/1800). The Baldwin family left Vermont prior to the 1810 census and traveled to Ontario settling in the Grimsby-Burford area. No record of other children born to Jesse and Olive has been found.

Known children born to Jesse Baldwin and Catherine (Caty) Clapp are Joseph C. (1818), Olive Gasset (1824), Melissa Catherine (1829) and Abisha M. (1832). Jesse Baldwin married Esther McMillan, a widow according to the Grimsby marriage license, on 6/20/1834 so it is surmised that Catherine Clapp Baldwin died prior to that date and perhaps as a result of childbirth in 1832 although no record to that effect has been found. The final resting place of Catherine Clapp has not been determined.

Joseph C. Baldwin emigrated to the U.S., married and settled in Michigan. He has been traced through public documents. Olive Gasset Baldwin married Allen Kennedy in Ontario, Canada. They had 4 children and she died in 1851 in Ontario. Allen Kennedy was instrumental in developing the Ward Cemetery there in 1851 and Olive is buried in that cemetery. Melissa Catherine Baldwin married James David Morgan and bore him 10 children. The family emigrated to the U.S. in 1864 and settled in Wisconsin, ultimately at Packwaukee. Little is known about Abisha Morgan other than his marriage to Mary Ann Waterson in Canada. In contrast a good deal is known about the children of James Morgan and Melissa Baldwin. Jesse Baldwin, husband of Catherine, emigrated to the U.S. after marrying Esther and settled near Milton, WI and is buried in Milton Cemetery.
