David Gilbert Sager, son of Elizabeth Waldemeier, sister of John Walden Meyers, was b. 5 December 1765; bapt. 8 December 1765 at St. Paul's Luth. Ch. of Wurtemberg, Rhinebeck, Dutchess Co., NY, as David Seger. He apparently changed the spelling of his name to Sager, and added the middle name, Gilbert. The bapt. record said "she swore the child to David Seger before Esq. Lister". John Waldemeier and his Frau, Mary, were witnesses. David had several half-brothers and sisters from his mother's marriage to John Garrett, but they will be listed in Vol. 2.

d. ca. 1849 at Albury, Ameliasburgh Twp., Prince Edward Co., Ont.; bur.-(place not identified, but perhaps in the Albury Cem. where so many of the Sagers are buried.)

m. ca. 1789 at Carrying Place, Ameliasburgh Twp., by Elder Joseph Wyner, Baptist, for "1 York shilling", Catherine Weese, only dau. of John Weese, Sr., U.E.L., who had located in the twp. in 1783, and Juliana Hogel, wid. of . . . Pellum. (John Weese, Sr., had m.(1) Arrientlje Hogel in 1761 and had 5 children. She d. in NY and he m.(2) her sister, Juliana, who was then a widow.) David and Catherine were the first white couple married in the twp. of Ameliasburgh. Catherine was b. 3 May 1773; bapt. 12 November 1774 at Schaghticoke, Rensselaer Co., NY; d. after 1844.

Tradition says that David G. Sager came to Upper Canada with his Uncle John Walden Meyers in 1787. He was a blacksmith, making ploughs, hoes, shovels, and other utensils which were needed at that time.

In 1790 they lived in Ameliasburgh Twp., Prince Edward Co., Ont., perhaps with the Weese family. In 1803 they lived on the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 91, Conc. 1, Ameliasburgh Twp. David was a Capt., Major, and Col. in the U.C. Militia, court and general training being held many years at his place of residence, the old homestead, listed above.

Catherine was granted 200 acres in Lot 87, Conc. 2, as dau. of a Loyalist. The land was in her possession in 1787. She sold it to John Sager, her son, in 1844. He sold it to William Rosebush, his brother-in-law, in 1861.
