Reid, says: "November 9, 1839-On 26<sup>th</sup> ult. suddenly Jane, wife of Henry Nugent of the Twp. of Sombra, western Dist., and dau. of John R. Bleecker of Murray.") Sombra is S. of Moore Twp. in Lambton Co., Ont. (I believe this would make her death date 26 October 1839, not 9 November.)

## II. George Bleeker (See V.I, p.37)

George Bleecker, Esq., d. 16 June 1867 in the 77th year of his age. (D.I.-18 June 1867) (1851-1861 census)

His wife, Alice, d. 5 October 1870, age 68 (D.I.-6 October 1870)

(Her age doesn't correspond with age on censuses. 1851 census calls her Alice-57; 1861 census calls her Almira-63; she is called Alice, "relict of the late George Bleecker, Esq." in the obit.) Alice left the lands at 260 Dundas St. East "as used and enjoyed by George Bleecker for over 46 years" to their 3 grandchildren. (Belleville Heritage, V.II-1983)

A. "Anna Maria Bleecker, only dau. of George, d. 5 July 1863, of apoplexy, in her 45th year." She was wife of A.R. Dougall, Esq. She d. in Belleville. (W.I.-10 July 1863) (1861 census)

Her age at d. makes her b. date ca. 1818. This makes more sense with the date of her 1st m. in 1834. I believe she was his only child.

m.(1) Judge Benjamin Dougall d. bet. 30 March 1857, when his will was dated, and 27 January 1858, when the petition for adm. was filed, leaving wid., Anna Maria. No children were named.

m.(2) bet. 1858-1861 Allen Ranney Dougall, who d. after 1891 (1861-1891 census)

He must have m.(2) ca. 1871-1872 . . . . ., who d. bef. 1876, as the Weekly Inquirer reported the birth of a son to the wife of A.R. Dougall at Belleville 20 September 1872. The child apparently d.y. bef. 1881. Allen was called a widower in the 1871 census.

Allen m.(3) 11 July 1876 Clara Isabella Dixon, 2nd dau. of Anthony Dixon, Esq., of Belleville; b. ca. 1858; d. (1881 census, and perhaps 1891; wife in 1891 is called Sarah on census, but she is right age to be Clara.) (m. rec. in D.I. & W.I.)
