## Foreword

V.I- Family of John Walden Meyers and Mary/Polly Gruber/Kruger, dealt mainly with the eldest son of George and Margaretha Waldemeier, Johannes/Hans Waldemeier, who became John Walden Meyers, a Loyalist spy. It also included the family of the oldest son of John's sister, Elizabeth, who followed his uncle to settle in the Bay of Quinte area.

V. II covered the additions and corrections to V.I.

V.III will deal mainly with the New York branches of the family, brothers and sisters of John, most of whom remained in or near the Hudson River Valley. I will carry these families only through the 1860 census period for the most part, although I may have information on some families later.

I had planned to choose one spelling of the name to use regularly, but I found myself using various spellings as they appeared on records, so you will find several different spellings of some of the names. I have found the name spelled in all the following ways-Waldemeier/Waldemier/Waldenmeier/Waldenmeyer/Waldmeyer/Waltemeyer/Waltermier/Waltermire/Waltemyer/Waltermeier/Waltermeyer/Waltermier/Waltermire/Waltermyer/Waltermyre/Waltmayer/Waltmeier/Watermyer/Watimer/Wattemer, and Watturman. I have tried to use the two most common forms-Waldenmeyer and Waltermire, but several forms may appear as they were on the original records.
